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NATIONAL FOREWORD

This Sri Lanka Standard was approved by the Sectoral Committee on Textiles, Clothing and Leather and was authorized for adoption and publication as a Sri Lanka Standard by the Council of the Sri Lanka Standards Institution on 2003-08-28.

This series of standards supersedes SLS 1130 : Method for determination of tearing force of woven fabrics.

This part of the standard is identical with ISO 13937-2 : 2000, Textiles Tear Properties of fabrics. Part 2 : Determination of tear force of trouser shaped test specimens (Single tear method), published by the International Organization for Standardization.

Terminology and Convention

The text of international standard has been accepted as suitable for publication without deviation as a Sri Lanka Standard. However certain terminology and conventions are not identical with those used in Sri Lanka Standards, attention is therefore drawn to the following ;

- a) whenever the words “International Standard/Publication” appear referring to this standard they should be interpreted as Sri Lanka Standard.
- b) The comma has been used as a decimal marker. In Sri Lanka Standards it is the current practice to use a full point on the baseline as the decimal marker.

Whenever page numbers are quoted they are ISO page numbers.
