NATIONAL FOREWORD

This Sri Lanka Standard was approved by the Sectoral Committee on Food Products and was authorized for adoption and publication as a Sri Lanka Standard by the Council of the Sri Lanka Standards Institution on.....

This Standard is identical with **ISO/ TS 22002 - 5: 2019**, Prerequisite programmes on food safety – part 5: Transport and storage, which is published by the International Organization for Standardization (ISO).

This document specifies requirements for establishing, implementing and maintaining prerequisite programme (PRPs) for transport and storage in the food chain to assist in controlling food safety hazards in organizations involved in transport and storage activities across the food supply chain, regardless of size or complexity.

Live animals are excluded from the scope of this document except when intended for direct consumption, e.g.: molluscs, crustaceans and live fish.

Terminology and conventions;

The text of the International Standard has been accepted as suitable for publication, without deviation, as a Sri Lanka Standard. However, certain terminology and conventions are not identical with those used in Sri Lanka Standards. Attention is therefore drawn to the following:

- a) Wherever the words “International Standard” appear referring to this Standard, it should be interpreted as “Sri Lanka Standard”.
- b) The comma has been used throughout as a decimal marker. In Sri Lanka Standards it is the current practice to use the full point on the base line as the decimal marker.
- c) Wherever page numbers are quoted, they are ISO page numbers.
